President Michael Garcia called the meeting to order at 12:02 p.m. The prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were led by Ms. Tammy Haydel. The meeting was held at the Government Tower Administrative Conference Room, 8026 Main Street, in Houma.

Members recorded as present were: Dr. Michael Garcia, Mr. Jason Underwood, Mr. Nicholas Hebert, Mr. Robert Barthel, Mr. Joe Boudreaux, II and Mr. C.J. Also present were Mr. Cohen Guidry, TEDA's CEO, Ms. Tammy Haydel, TEDA's Executive Group Assistant and Mr. Gary Williams, Sr.

President Garcia made three calls for public wishing to address the committee with no response.

Mr. Hebert motioned to approve the September 13, 2022 TEDA Board Meeting Minutes as submitted, seconded by Mr. Barthel. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Barthel motioned to approve the Engagement Letter as submitted; seconded by Mr. Boudreaux. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Guidry requested the Board to consider continuing the \$300K line of credit with Synergy Bank at a cost of \$250 annually. The Board requested he research the fee to increase the line of credit to \$500K. As such, it will be readdressed at the next board meeting.
