KEY POINTS

- 3 The wide distribution and sharing of accurate information regarding the COVID-19 vaccine is a critical component for Louisiana as we work to reopen our businesses and rebuild our economy.
- 4 Studies show that COVID-19 vaccines are very effective at keeping you from getting COVID-19. Experts also think that getting a COVID-19 vaccine may help keep you from getting seriously ill even if you do get COVID-19. These vaccines cannot give you the disease itself.

BENEFITS TO EMPLOYERS
