

Bayou Business Recovery Network Guidelines

The Bayou Business Recovery Network program was launched to provide technical assistance for businesses suffering from the negative impacts of the COVID-19 public health response in Terrebonne Parish.


Terrebonne Parish small business will be able to access three levels of service through the Bayou Business Recovery Network programming:

- **Recovery Seminar Series.** The Recovery Seminar Series will be widely available and cover general topics where we have seen a need in the local business community. Attendance will be free (with limited seating available due to COVID restrictions). Topics will include:
 - Financial Services
 - Marketing
 - Management Training
 - Human Resources
 - Legal
 - Digital Technical Assistance
 - Spanish Language Education
- Individual Network Support Opportunities. The Individual Network Support Opportunities present a follow up opportunity for those local small businesses who need a more individualized support plan. TEDA staff will meet with each company to discuss their current challenges and help create a support plan, through our partners, to ensure each company has access to the various programs and opportunities available.
- Individual Consultative Support. The Individual Consultative Support will provide those local small businesses with more complex challenges an opportunity to engage with a member of our consulting network. This program will be free for companies who can demonstrate a specific challenge presented by the global pandemic. NOTE: Funding is limited, and the consultative support will only be available until funding is exhausted. Companies are not guaranteed individual access to a consultant.

Eligibility

The Recovery Seminar Series and Individual Network Support Opportunities will be available to all existing small businesses in Terrebonne Parish and those looking to start a new business.

Individualized Consultative Support will be available only for small businesses who are located or operate primarily in Terrebonne Parish and were in business prior to March 11, 2020. These services will be awarded based on demonstrated need in a written application and only after the company has attended the Recovery Seminar Series and met with TEDA staff to identify other resources available.
